



## Public Art Docent - PODA Project

- General Duties:** The Portable On Demand Arts (PODA) Project is a temporary public art exhibition featuring eight PODS® containers on display at Discovery Green. Using the containers as palettes or platforms for creative expression, each artist or collective of artists will explore and reveal Houston's aspirations as a significant 21st century cultural capital. Docents will be provided with information regarding each PODS® container in order to interact with and engage visitors in this public art experience. Volunteers for this position should be outgoing, friendly, and interested in art. This shift is outdoors and requires mobility.
- Location:** Please check-in at the Volunteer Office, Room 340A in the George R. Brown Convention Center at least 20 minutes prior to the start time of your shift. Don't forget to allow time for traffic, parking, and to walk from your car to the Volunteer Office.
- Dress:** Please wear your AAM Volunteer T-shirt with khaki pants or skirt and comfortable shoes. If you bring a jacket or sweater, please bring one that opens in the front as to not hide your Volunteer T-Shirt. If you do not obtain a shirt before the day of your shift, you can get one in the Volunteer Office, Room 340A before you begin work.
